Challenge Payment

CC Open Registration Policy

Foundations and Challenge Program Open Registration begins Feb 1st or later for the following school year. Until Feb 1st current program families have pre-registration priority.

Check with the Program Director to find out when their Open Registration begins.

Late Fees Unpaid tuition will be assessed a 2% monthly penalty on the balance.

If you are concerned about paying on time, please work out a different payment plan with your Director.

Refunds Monies collected for registration, supplies, and copies are *non-refundable* and *non-transferable*. The Director may refund a portion of your prepaid tuition if the Director finds someone to replace your student.

***Facility Fee** varies from location to location. Check with the program director for their particular facility fee.

_____ I understand that the supply fee for the Essentials class is \$20 and is due when registering for the class and with the registration/supply fee for Foundations.

_____ I understand that parent attendance of the classes is a requirement in Essentials. I understand that I will be asked to take an active role in class by acting as a Table Mom. Table Moms watch for children at their table that need help completing exercises, listen to recitations, record incentive points, and help with games.

At Home Time Commitment:

The Essentials tutor introduces and reviews material each week, and encourages students in their "joy of learning". It is the parent who must consistently guide and instruct the student at home each week, in order to ensure their student(s) achieve mastery in language arts and writing.

In writing, parents will utilize the tools and methods of the *Institute for Excellence*. These models and stylistic techniques are introduced in class to give the student a start for the week or a particular writing project.

The weekly EEL Lessons (language arts lessons) are introduced in class by the tutor. At home, parents then review the material introduced in class during the following week using Classical Conversations' *The Essentials of the English Language Guide*, which contains weekly lessons for the parent and student to work through, as well as the "grammar" of language the students are to commit to memory.

A quick survey of first-year Essentials parents, indicates that successful families are spending anywhere from two to three hours on all Essentials' work (writing and language arts), three-to-four days a week. Experienced Essentials' families, that have invested time in the initial learning curve of the materials, find that it takes about half the time to thoroughly cover and teach the material each week.
